The BEC project seeks to improve life quality of people with disabilities in the Polish-Ukraine borderland. The partners established two new Centres of Conductive Education: the one in Kremenets District (UA) provides complex support and daily, ambulatory and temporary attention services to over 100 children with motor and mental disorders. A second one, in Zamość (PL) offers care and professional attention to adults with motor, mental, speech, sight and hearing impairments. The project also provided a training to 50 Polish and Ukrainian therapists, creating a basis for further joint work and cooperation between the two countries. Thanks to the provision of high-quality social services and an integrated rehabilitation system, BEC creates the necessary conditions to prevent the social exclusion of people with disabilities.
