The Bug River is shared by Poland, Ukraine and Belarus. People living on both sides of the river have much in common: traditions, folklore, and food culture. The regional cuisine of the Bug valley - Podlasie and the Lviv Oblast – treasures recipes of old dishes such as “vereshchaka”, “krewianka” or “szponderok” which have a strong potential for attracting tourists. The BugCuisine project preserves this precious heritage, reviving and sharing the recipes of the traditional dishes with local communities in a series of culinary workshops, contests and food festivals. The recipes promoted during the workshops are collected in a special cookbook (both paper and digital), available for any lover of traditional local cuisine.
