Increasing local capacities to monitor, prevent and respond to disasters is a common goal for four disaster management institutions – partners of the Co-Prevent project. They have developed common mechanisms to improve data sharing and information exchange on the environment and early warning in the Black Sea Basin area. Observation points using solar energy were installed in the participating countries to monitor and signal wild forest fires, river floods and other risks. Moreover, the project has provided trainings in rescue, research, first aid and disaster management to various groups of volunteers from Türkiye, Bulgaria, Greece and the Republic of Moldova.
