A significant quantity of marine litter flows into the Black Sea from rivers. The CROCuS project focuses on the prevention and reduction of river litter through a wide range of local actions: assessment of waste volume located in the proximity to rivers, awareness-raising among population, and implementation of waste management practices. The project developed a Waste Alert Mobile Application which helps to report a spotted waste problem (e.g. an illegal dumping) to the local authorities, to find the closest recycling center and to get news on waste management and clean-up days. The partners have organised teacher trainings and experience sharing workshops, demonstration activities on composting and clean-up activities on the Prut, Dnieper and Tundzha rivers.
