ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The RETRANS project improves transport infrastructure in the border area between Romania and the Republic of Moldova, with the aim to facilitate accessibility and transit of goods and people at the border point Sculeni (RO) - Sculeni (MD). The bypass road towards the border point Sculeni is strategic for Ungheni district (MD) as it serves both the local community and the companies from the Ungheni Business free economic zone. The project reconstructs this road sector by placing new track surface, repairing sidewalks, putting road signs and street lighting. On the Romanian side, the project has modernized the existing roads of the Tehnopolis park. In addition, the project partners are upgrading the surrounding roads, arranging sidewalks, parking spaces, a waiting room and a dining room for truck drivers stationed for customs procedures. Part of the project foresees the installation of 54 street lighting poles with photovoltaic panels and video surveillance.
