Huge quantities of reusable goods are prematurely disposed for recycling. The REUSEMED project increases the involvement of the community into reusing objects in the Mediterranean, by creating reuse circuits for different types of waste in four partner cities (SP, IT, JO and TN). These circuits include food, clothes, baby toys, home appliances, waste from electrical and electronic equipment, books, and papers. The partners have also designed and tested composting installations, food collection points in markets, repair and reuse centers, reuse corners in shops and repairing cafés. A dedicated app helps to connect users and reuse networks managers. The reuse networks are planned to become self-sustainable, creating new job opportunities in the region.
