On top of purchasing individual and collective protection materials, the partners organize common trainings and experience exchanges to create a common understanding of the techniques in fighting organized crime and to develop necessary skills and spirit for managing high risk interventions, which impact the safety of the whole team. At the same time common trainings aim to streamline interventions tactics, techniques and procedures ensuring the legality of all actions taken. Through combined physical and psychical techniques, the project also helps to perform the evaluation of the personnel as best fitting for high-risk missions.
