Ensuring public safety and strengthening the fight against organized crime in Ivano-Frankivsk and Solotvyno (Ukraine), Sighet and Baia Mare (Romania) are the key objectives of the “Safe Future” project. Four data centers established in the project cities and linked to the video surveillance systems allow for a rapid processing of digital information. The new ICT infrastructure helps to effectively manage illegal migration, smuggling of goods and person trafficking, to prevent terrorist manifestations and emergency situations, as well as to protect citizens’ lives and maintain public order.
