ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The 15th century Ardud fortress in Satu Mare County (RO) and the 16th century Pniv Castle in Ivano-Frankivsk Oblast (UA) belong to the national architectural heritage attracting an increasing number of tourists. The Sharing Heritage project aims to increase the tourist potential of both cultural assets ensuring, however, their preservation and maintenance. The project develops urban planning documentation for Pniv Fortress, including a ground penetrating radar analysis, a 3D model, architecture and landscape design, etc. Ardud fortress receives high-power dehumidifiers to control air humidity and provide ventilation, ground lighting systems in the fortress galleries and renewed entrance gates. In addition, the project partners prepare tourist guides and fortress maps, as well as produce promotional videos about these historical sites.
