The TBCHB project reduces the disparities in the prevention and early therapy of tuberculosis existing between the project partner organizations. The lung screening system developed by the Hungarian pulmonary profession in collaboration with the World Health Organization no longer uses lung screening with radiation exposure. This experience and professional guidance are valuable to improve tuberculosis prevention and detection on the Ukrainian side. The project facilitates sharing know-how, it upgrades radiology testing and acquires low-radiation digital chest X-rays, scanners, and other equipment in order to reduce the infection transmission on both sides of the border.
