Focusing on the Gothic period – which carries a remarkable cultural significance across Europe – the project aims to bring Poland and Ukraine closer together by highlighting their shared history. Indeed, despite the presence of Gothic relics in both countries, not enough research has been done on these Germanic tribes, leaving many people unaware of this part of history. The outdated infrastructure of local museums has failed to capture public interest, and this has lead the project to decide to revive two key museums: the Gothic Village in Masłomęcz (PL), and the Volodymyr-Volynskyi Historical Museum (UA). Through innovative additions like interactive touch panels, virtual 3D models, and multimedia films such as "Gothic Life" and "Magic Gothic Tale", these museums have now become popular tourist destinations welcoming diverse range of visitors (adults, children, locals, and tourists) while also making the infrastructures accessible to disabled guests.
