Key initiatives include the construction of a Paediatrics Pavilion and Internal Medicine sections within Tîrgu Bujor Town Hospital (RO), alongside the rehabilitation of the Hîncești Health Center (MD). Additionally, the project facilitates cross-border training for medical-sanitary personnel through courses, exchanges of experience, and international conferences. Furthermore, efforts are made to increase awareness and promote healthy behaviors among residents of both regions. Through comprehensive educational campaigns and outreach initiatives, individuals are empowered with the knowledge and resources needed for improved well-being.
