The western regions of Ukraine are facing a massive inflow of internal migrants who are pushed away from their homes by the Russian troops. The Mazovia4UA project provides for the basic needs to the local communities in Ukraine, allowing them to survive during the war. The Polish beneficiary has purchased and transported to Ukraine food, kitchen equipment, hygiene products, orthopaedic equipment and power generators. The project was also involved in equipping social centres and hospitals specialising in geriatric, psychological and orthopaedic care. Equipment and materials were received by Lviv Regional Military Administration, Caritas Spes Religious Mission “Caritas-Spes” Lviv Archdiocese of the Roman Catholic Church, Kulparkov Psychiatric Hospital in Lviv, Lviv National Art Galery, Caritas of Sambor-Drohobycz Diocese, Regional Development and Innovation Agency “Mizhhirya” Centre to improve the conditions of people affected by the war.
