There are different ethnic communities living in Botoșani (Romania) and Bălți (Rep. of Moldova) – Jews, Armenians, Russian Ukrainians, Poles, Roma, and Lipovan Russians. Facilitating interpersonal connections among members of various ethnic communities – as well as strengthening institutional relations between the project partner organizations – were the key objectives of the project “Multi-ethnic Cross-Border Cultural Center”. The partners organized many cultural events within the local ethnic communities of Botoșani and Bălți and produced information materials (including websites) about them. These activities helped to involve several institutions supporting ethnic communities and to establish the Multicultural Cross-Border Cultural Centre at the “Eugen Coșeriu” Municipal Library in Bălți.
