Pintea the Brave was a famous heroic rebel born in 1670 in Romania. Similar in many ways to Robin Hood, he was an outlaw who attacked nobles in order to provide food, clothing and money for the poor. His struggle became a common symbol for Romanians and Ukrainians, a landmark uniting the two peoples. The Pintea Heritage project promotes their common history and cultural heritage by increasing the tourism potential of border communities. A common tourist destination created around the character of Pintea the Brave, includes cross-border tourist routes (Pintea's path) and integrated cultural events. The municipality of Arduș has created an outdoor space for medieval festivals around the Arduș Fortress, it has developed the park area and set up the Camp for Little Knights (an area dedicated to medieval educational events for children). The municipality of Vyshkovo has modernized the historical center – paving, benches, an artesian fountain, ornamental flowers, playgrounds for children, etc. The facilities are being used for the thematic route and for the organization of annual joint festivals.
