The National Research Centres (NRCs) are the main producers of research and development results in the Mediterranean region; however, these results are not transferred to society through Public Procurement of Innovation (PPI), the public procurement of innovative goods and services that are being introduced into the market for the first time. The PPI4MED project transfers the successful framework for Innovation Procurement, developed by the European Union, to the Mediterranean Partner Countries, creating a cross-border market for research and development results. This was done by co-designing solutions in 5 national and 1 cross-border Living Labs, and by conducting 12 real processes to raise awareness among policymakers to include PPI as a strategic tool to transfer results as part of the science policy in each country concerned.
