The three municipalities work together to identify, assess, and reduce risks associated with hazards and human activities that threaten cross-border territory; and they do so by developing solutions for effective joint interventions in case of disasters. The equipment purchased within the project – water pumps, inflatable dams, power generators, excavators, firefighter trucks, etc. – serve now to protect the communities from floods, fires and other natural and manmade disasters. In Moftin (Romania) and Vásárosnamény (Hungary) the partners have built and rehabilitated infrastructure used by the local emergency units. The project has also facilitated professional cooperation among the specialized units from the three countries, as well as raised awareness on disaster prevention among the local population and school children.
