ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

A well-coordinated work of police, firefighters and medics is crucial to reduce response time in emergency situations. The RescUE project developed the ICT infrastructure between Romania and the Republic of Moldova to improve communication between the structures intervening in case of cross-border emergency situations. In the frame of the project, two integrated dispatch center – one in Bălți (MD) and one in Iași county (RO) – were built and equipped according to European standards. As well, the partners elaborated a joint document which describes the mechanism of communication and coordination between the two centers during cross-border emergencies and in daily work.
