Greece, Bulgaria and Georgia share a common cultural background of travelling and trading goods between these countries by sea. The SABS project increases tourist flows between the port of the Black Sea and the Aegean Sea by having created six new maritime tourist routes (two for each participating country). Thanks to the project, new floating docks serve tourist boats in the Alexandroupoulos Port in Greece, and a new eco-friendly tourist boat sails from the Burgas port in Bulgaria. The partners developed a complete guide for boat owners wishing to travel between Black Sea ports and Northern Aegean Ports. Three movable tourist info points were opened in the three countries, providing tools and results of the project together with an interactive database.
