ENI-CROSS BORDER COOPERATION

The SAGA project has strengthened cooperation between police forces in Romania and Ukraine through the exchange of operational information and the improvement of the operational and technical capacity of the police structures. 78 police and border police facilities in the cross-border area were modernized and equipped, building a more robust and responsive law enforcement infrastructure along the border. The established cross-border cooperation IT platform significantly boosted communication and information exchange between the police services of Romania and Ukraine. Over 760 professionals were engaged in the joint capacity-building activities – exchanges of experience, study visits and comprehensive training sessions – contributing to the long-term impact of the project.
