By restoring buildings with deep historical roots in Iași (RO) and Fălești (MD), the “Traveller on Cultural Meridians” project aims at preserving the cultural heritage of these border towns, while promoting sustainable tourism development. In the framework of the project, the traditional Ion Creanga Memorial House (RO) and the Lazar Dubinovschi Districtual History and Ethnography Museum (MD) underwent modernisation, enhancing the capacity to promote the rich demography and traditions of the region. In addition, the project repaired the historical paved road in the center of Fălești ensuring maintenance of the town’s heritage. Restoration efforts were complemented by artistic events, exhibitions, and conferences designed to increase public engagement. By upgrading these sites and introducing new programs, the project aims not only to strengthen the local cultural landscape, but also to attract more visitors.
